Like many other local villages, Ravensworth has established a support group for older and more vulnerable residents – a group of local volunteers who do shopping and other necessary chores, on a rota basis. An amusing story from one couple who have been given some help from the support group:

Coronavirus restrictions can bring out the best in people

My wife and I are both over 70 (and a little bit more) and have been helped by several deliverers in Ravensworth.

We complete our list in advance, usually a combined effort. On one occasion I added 'Pringles' to the list. My wife jumped at me saying 'that's not an essential item'. We told our 'runner' but she said nothing. When the goods arrived, there were my Pringles – Hurrah! We told this story to one of our other deliverers. She returned with two boxes of Pringles. However, that's not the end. That same evening at about 7 pm there was a knock on the front door (a door rarely used). Two little girls about 8 and 6 with their mother nearby offered me a small carrier bag – guess what! More Pringles. I thanked them and told this story to my wife.

We now have enough Pringles to last until restrictions are lifted!

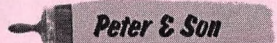
