Recently Newsham residents Anne and Kate volunteered to pick up litter from Dyson Lane and also from Low Lane, between Rokeby Inn and the village itself. Our thanks to them for their efforts which are very much appreciated.

Unfortunately, they managed to fill eight black sacks!! The litter on Low Lane was particularly bad. Some may have blown out of residents' recycling bins on collection days but it is clear the great majority had not.

The amount of fast food packaging, some with uneaten left overs still in them, sandwich wrappers, half empty bottles and cans, not to mention many other items, was significant. Commercial delivery vehicles may be a factor but the sheer amount sadly suggests that a minority of local traffic accessing villages is also playing a part in the problem.

- Calls from Amazon stating you have credit on your account and that they wish to send you the money back.
 They will try to get you to do it on your computer, it won't work & they will then ask to take control of your computer and then proceed to empty your account.
- People ringing you purporting to be from the NHS asking you to pay money in order to get your COVID vaccination.


