

KEEP COMMUNICATING & KEEP THE LETTERS COMING!

KEEP THE HOME FIRES BURNING - BUT NOT WITH COAL AND WET WOOD

There have been rumours around Barningham that sources of traditional house coal are still to be had for burning. I should like to point out to anyone locally still unaware, that burning fires at home with traditional house coal or wet wood is a major source of the pollutant PM2.5 - tiny particles which can enter the bloodstream and lodge in lungs and other organs. PM2.5 has been identified by the World Health Organisation as the most serious air pollutant for human health. As a consequence, sales of bagged traditional house coal and wet wood have been unlawful since 1 May 2021.

People with log burners and open fires can still use them, but are required to buy cleaner alternative fuels such as dry wood and manufactured solid fuels which produce less smoke. Both of these cleaner options are just as easy to source and more efficient to burn, making them more cost effective. Burning dry wood also produces more heat and less soot than wet wood and can reduce emissions by up to 50%. A certification scheme sees suitable products certified and labelled by suppliers to ensure that they can be easily identified, and retail outlets are only permitted to sell fuel that is accompanied by the correct label.

Alongside road traffic, wood and coal burning is a major source of fine particulate matter (PM2.5) pollution, the most worrying form of pollution to human health. It's vital that we tackle all of these sources of air pollution and raise awareness about the dangers of air pollutants so people can make the best choices for their own health as well as the health of others around them.






