K6 returns!

When BT came to re-locate a telephone box in Whorlton back in the 1980s, following a complaint that the coin collectors were making too much noise at 3 o'clock in the morning, many people were dismayed to see that BT had replaced the old K6 with a new glass box.

"It was a clear case of BT getting their wires crossed," said George Stastny, who has lived in Whorlton Village since 1973. "The village was not consulted about the swap and many of us have long felt that we wanted our red telephone box back again.

"These classic examples of British design should never have been removed; they form an iconic part of our surroundings, a finishing touch to our towns and villages. And it's no wonder that the glass replacements were being underused; being made of glass they were virtually invisible so no one could ever find them!"


