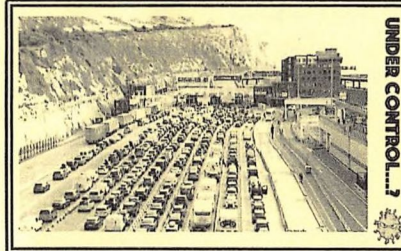

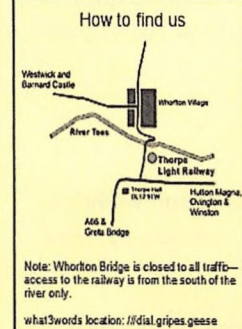

continued increase in reports about scams where victims are targeted on WhatsApp by criminals

conversation with "Hello Mum" or "Hello Dad" and will say that they are texting from a new mobile
number as their phone was lost or damaged. They will then ask for money to purchase a new one, or
claim that they need money urgently to pay a bill. The criminal will provide bank details for the payment
to be made to, with some coming back with further demands for money. **How to protect yourself:**
STOP. THINK. CALL. If a family member or friend makes an unusual request on WhatsApp, always
call the person to confirm their identity.

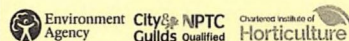

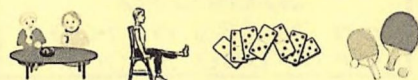

WHORLTON NOTICES

K6 returns!

When BT came to re-locate a telephone box in Whorlton back in the 1980s, following a complaint that the coin collectors were making too much noise at 3 o'clock in the morning, many people were dismayed to see that BT had replaced the old K6 with a new glass box.

"It was a clear case of BT getting their wires crossed," said George Stastny, who has lived in Whorlton Village since 1973. "The village was not consulted about the swap and many of us have long felt that we wanted our red telephone box back again."

"These classic examples of British design should never have been removed; they form an iconic part of our surroundings, a finishing touch to our towns and villages. And it's no wonder that the glass replacements were being underused; being made of glass they were virtually invisible so no one could ever find them!"

"I want to thank all those people who have contributed to the K6 fund; in particular, people from the village who made donations, as well as the parish council, the Community Association and the county councillors James Rowlandson and George Richardson with Anna Lisa helping with the administration of the grant from DCC."

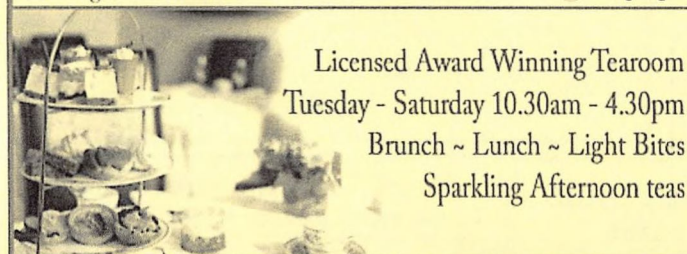
