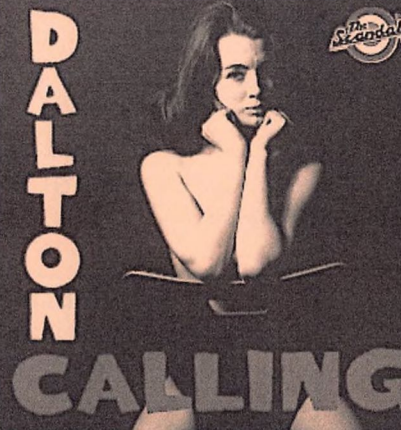

Barningham 100 Club

This year as we have sold fewer than 100 shares, we plan to run the draw slightly differently to previous years. As most people will be aware we have a defibrillator which is situated at the front of the village hall. I am in the process of reinstating the instructions on the front of the cabinet which seem to have faded away and thought that this would be a good time to make everyone aware of what to do if the defibrillator is needed.

The first thing you should do is to dial 999 and the ambulance responder will give you the code to open the cabinet.

If you have already dialled 999 from somewhere else and not been given the code it is 9999 and then press the tick, you will then be able to open the cabinet by pulling the front firmly towards you.

Please let me know if you have accessed the defibrillator as I need to either clean it or replace the pads if they have been used.

ENERGY REBATE SCAM: Action Fraud is warning the public about a sharp rise in reports relating to fake emails purporting to be from Ofgem, the independent energy regulator for Great Britain. The emails claim that the recipient is due a rebate payment as part of a government scheme and provides links for the recipient to follow in order to apply for the rebate. The links in the emails lead to malicious websites designed to steal personal and financial information. E-mail subject header "Claim your bill rebate now". Offenders are using the Ofgem brand logo and colours to make the emails look as authentic as possible. However, the emails ask recipients to "apply for an energy bill rebate before September 2020", which is what prompted many recipients to realise the emails weren't genuine.

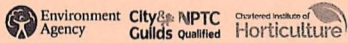

As the then Village Hall Treasurer when the Fountain was last renovated (circa £9,000) I've been concerned at the increasing frequency of it being used as a parking place.

The mason who did the work was clear that it was not designed to have vehicles on it and that it would deteriorate under that use. The stone flags are bedded on mortar and if these crack it is likely that water will wash out the mortar leading to further damage.

I recognise that this is the most congested part of the village, but it would be a shame if more expensive renovation becomes necessary.

I have asked to have this raised at the next Parish Meeting. In the meantime could we ask local residents to avoid parking on this flagged area, and to ask their visitors to respect this as well.
