## The Parish Charter

## Dear Colleague

Today's adoption of the Parish Charter by the Executive has cemented the shared belief that by working closely together North Yorkshire Council and the Parish Councils, Town Councils, City Council and Parish Meetings will make a vital contribution to the well-being of the communities we all serve. The Charter sets out how we will work together for the benefit of local people in maintaining and improving local services and facilities and influencing and lobbying on future local development. North Yorkshire Council values the standing that Parish Councils, Town Councils, City Council and Parish Meetings have amongst their residents. You have a closeness to residents and are the first tier of local government to the communities you serve.
