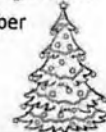

WHASHTON NEWS

Covid -19 – please make sure you keep yourselves safe, follow the guidelines and be neighbourly. Some of the Parish do not have internet access and so do not get emails – however, I do try to hand deliver important messages to all. If you need assistance or know of someone who does, please let me know: gally.zaranko@gmail.com or 01748824185.

New Bin – we have a proper new waste bin situated by the corner of Rachel Lane next to the grit bin. This will be emptied fortnightly when the waste team are in the village to do the normal bins. I requested, and got, additional stickers that indicate dog waste is allowed to be put into this bin. I am exploring some additional signage to indicate the bin for walkers through the village.

Precept – this year we have seen no social activities to help support the costs of upkeep of the parish so setting a precept this year is going to have to reflect this. John attended a virtual meeting with RDC on 11th November and we, as a committee, will be contacting you in early December with details of this year's proposals, sharing relevant information and giving you the opportunity to comment upon the proposal and cast your vote.

The Slow Ways Project - this project was set up by Dan Raven-Ellison who is a geographer and explorer. His goal is to plot more than 4,000 walking routes on an online map using the 200,00km of footpaths and bridleways that trace their way between village, town and city. Unlike national trails and historic long-distance walks, the Slow Ways will not divert to local beauty spots or local point of interest. Slow Ways will be typically less than 20km and wherever possible pass through a village every 5km or so. These will be plotted on the Ordnance Survey OS Maps Platform. Each Slow Way will be named by the settlements it connects.

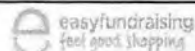

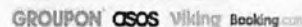
