

ELECTRICITY - LOCAL?



Dear Ed.

We had an interesting virtual meeting with our MP, Dehenna Davison, on Friday, attended by about 20 people from across the constituency. The alm of the meeting was to seek her support for the Local Electricity Bill, a private member's bill introduced by Peter Aldous, a Conservative MP. The bill seeks reform of the electricity supply regulatory system to reduce costs for small generators to supply electricity directly. Under the present system, the cost of becoming an electricity supplier is grossly disproportionate to small generators.

Currently, less than 0.5% of UK electricity is generated by community groups. If enacted, the proposed bill would give community-scale renewable energy a massive boost, helping the government achieve its goal for decarbonising electricity supply and providing a valuable source of additional income to the communities where it is produced. All this at no cost to the government and without significantly impacting on large-scale generating businesses.

The bill already has good cross-party support from 229 MPs but will need the support of around 400 MPs to ensure its passage into law. Neither of the MPs serving the Flyer distribution area support the bill at present; however, if their constituents express an interest, it should be easy to gain their support for a bill that will benefit everyone.

As we hope that other local communities will follow in the footsteps of Barningham, this bill should be of interest to all. Take 5 minutes to drop a note to your MP asking for their support! Further information can be found at Power for People
