

STRIMMERS & HEDGEHOGS DON'T GO

If you're using a strimmer in your garden or outside on the verges, please be aware that they're deadly to hedgehogs.

Hedgehogs use field borders, spaces under hedges, long grass and other hidey-holes to seek sanctuary from danger. Hedgehogs especially have no fight or flight response, they merely curl into a ball, which can lead to terrible injuries and death. If you must strim, check *very* carefully for hedgehogs before you start.

Slug pellets are also a danger to them. Hedgehogs, frogs and thrushes work well to rid your garden of slugs and snails.

- If you are out enjoying your garden, remember to shut and lock all windows and doors on the front of your property.
 If you cannot see the door or window, then it should be shut and locked.
- Keep your shed securely locked by using strong padlocks to BS EN 12320 standard. Use coach bolts or non-return screws to secure door hinges, hasp and staples.
- Planting prickly or barbed shrubbery along boundaries and fence lines acts as an effective natural barrier. Plants such as firethorn, climbing rose or hawthorn can be a powerful deterrent.






