The cost of space rockets...

As past members of Barningham Village Hall Committee, we understand the need to raise funds for the hall. However, getting into bed with Amazon's community scheme is not the right way forward. Amazon is notorious for re-routing its profits to off-shore, low tax, regimes, thus minimising the tax-take of the countries where they make their profit. Last year their UK pre-tax profits rose by 35% but their UK tax of £14.46 million rose by only 3.5%.

Amazon registers its UK sales in Luxembourg to avoid paying tax here. So, while it is under-cutting other UK retailers, such as bookshops, it is barely contributing to the costs of UK infrastructure and services, such as education and the NHS.

We can all use our spending power to influence global giants like Amazon by looking for locally based retailers instead. These will be paying tax in the UK, not exporting their profits, thus supporting our communities in a very real way.

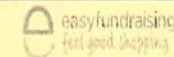
