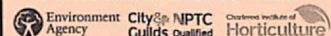

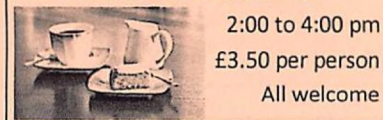

Ravensworth Celebrates

A celebration of the opening of the newly refurbished Ravensworth Community Village Hall on Saturday 28 August was attended by local Council leader Angie Dale and the ribbon was cut by man and boy resident Peter Wilson. Villagers enjoyed refreshments in and around the hall accompanied by music from a brass ensemble. Over the past two years, using community funds aided by grants from the National Lottery and Richmondshire, the building has undergone major transformation, as well as the installation of new toilets and a new kitchen. Weekly sessions including the Art Club and yoga have already begun, a tea and cake afternoon will take place on the last Sunday of each month starting 26 September and the popular themed meal events begin with a French Evening on 23 October. Work on the building continues with the repair of the windows due to start later in the year.

The Rokeby junction will be moved to the west side of Rokeby Church, adding miles to the trip to Barney and diverting traffic through Startforth and over the County Bridge, already struggling to cope. The route keeping the Rokeby turn close to its current site has been dropped because Historic England want to 'preserve' the ancient woodland that was mostly felled quite recently. Durham County and Barney Town Councils, and the Rokeby estate all supported this now-discarded location. We need to make strong representations.

The Barnard Castle junctions will be the focus at The Witham Hall from Saturday 9th October to Monday 11th. It's vital that local people go along, check the details and then respond to the consultation (up to November 6th).

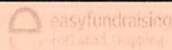

Living in the countryside - It's great to make the most of our surroundings, and take to our local paths and bridal ways. We've got some good routes around the fields and lanes where we live. It's important to keep to the marked ways so that crops and livestock are not affected. To help everyone know about how to use our rights and landowners/farmers, we've been surveying the area and have displayed the Countryside Code on our public noticeboards. Here are a few tips:

- Keep dogs under close control
- Close gates after use
- Stick to rights of way marked on OS maps and, if a path crosses a field of crops, follow the designated line rather than round the edge of the field.
